

# Delta Refund Status: How to Check, Track, and Speed Up Your Refund

2. **Enter your details**


You'll need:

- Your **ticket or document number** (starts with 006)
- Your **last name** as it appears on the ticket

3. **Track the progress**

Once submitted, the status will show if it's:

- **Processing**
- **Approved**
- **Refunded**
- **Declined**

## How Long Does a Delta Refund Take?


- **Credit card refunds:** Typically processed in **7–10 business days**
- **Other payment methods:** May take **up to 30 business days**

Note: Due to high volumes or unexpected disruptions (like weather or emergencies), processing may be delayed.

- Bank processing times

## Pro Tips to Speed Up Your Delta Refund

1. **Cancel early** – If you know you're not flying, cancel sooner.
2. **Submit refund request manually** – Don't wait for automatic processing.

3. **Avoid third-party travel sites** – Booking direct means fewer refund issues.
  4. **Follow up** – If it's been over 10 business days, call **1-844-723-0591**.

A: Wait 7–10 business days for credit card refunds. Then call **1-844-723-0591** to follow up if there's no update.
