

Canceling a United Flight? Here's How to Track Your Refund & Who to Call

What Happens When You Cancel a United Flight?

When you cancel a flight with United, one of three things usually happens:


1. You get a **full cash refund** (if the ticket is refundable)
2. You receive **United eCredits** (if the ticket is non-refundable)
3. You don't get anything (if your fare isn't eligible for either)

That's why it's important to check your **ticket type and United's refund policy** first.

How to Track Your United Airlines Refund

Here's how to check your **United refund status** after cancellation:

Step-by-Step:

1. Go to the refund status page:
 <https://www.united.com/en/us/refund-status>
2. Enter your:
 - **Ticket Number** (begins with 016)
 - **Passenger Last Name**
3. Click **Check Status**

Your refund will show as:

- **Pending**
- **Approved**
- **Refunded**
- **Declined**

If you don't see an update, you can call **1-844-723-0591** to speak with a live agent and get real-time assistance.



When Should You Call United Airlines About a Refund?

Call **1-844-723-0591** if:

- It's been more than **10 business days**
- You haven't received an email confirmation
- The refund tool doesn't recognize your ticket number
- You're confused about refund eligibility
- You need to update or fix your refund request



1-844-723-0591 is the direct line to United's refund support team, available 24/7.



How Long Do United Refunds Usually Take?

Refund time depends on the payment method:

- **Credit/Debit Cards:** 7–10 business days
- **Cash, Check, or PayPal:** Up to 30 days
- **eCredits:** Typically issued within 24–48 hours

If you're past that timeline, it's time to **call 1-844-723-0591** and ask for an update.

What Causes Refund Delays?

Delays can happen for several reasons:

- Incomplete or incorrect ticket info
- Third-party bookings (Expedia, etc.)
- Technical system errors
- Your bank holding the funds
- Non-refundable tickets submitted for refund

A: No, the ticket number is required. You can find it in your confirmation email.

Q: What if I booked through a travel agency?

A: You'll need to request the refund through that agency. United can only assist if booked directly.
